Fred noted that we are currently working in "dual mode" i.e. preparing a Neighbourhood Plan based on the possible needs to provide more dwellings or a Neighbourhood Plan based on the assumption that the provision of dwellings would be met elsewhere (Grazeley Village development) and that the emphasis would be on redevelopment of the infrastructure of Tilehurst Parish.

The meeting with West Berkshire Council will cover a number of different points and it was suggested by Fred that a request be made to record the meeting for the benefit of those Steering Group members who are not attending the meeting.

Carmelle stated that she is prepared to become a member of the Steering Group and this was agreed by the members present.
